



# LOGICALIS GOREY REGATTA NOTICE OF RACE 2016

*Organising Authority: Gorey Regatta Association*

This Notice of Race (NoR) consists of two main sections. Part 1 applies to all Gorey Regatta Association (GRA) organised races and includes rules that affect every race unless modified by Part 2, which details rules that apply to specific races. When a rule is modified in Part 2, it takes precedence over the rule in Part 1.

## PART 1

### 1.1 RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1.1.1 The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.1.2 The prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association shall apply. No other National Authority prescriptions shall apply.
- 1.1.3 Racing rule(s) 35, 61.3, 62.1 and 62.2 and will be changed. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.1.4 The Class rules and regulations of appropriate One-Design and/or Class rules, National Handicap for Cruisers (NHC) rules shall apply, except as varied below or in the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.1.5 This Notice of Race and any amendments thereto. Amendments to the Notice of Race will be published on the GRA website.
- 1.1.6 Sailing Instructions will be published after the Closing Date on the GRA website.

### 1.2 ADVERTISING

- 1.2.1 Competitor advertising must be in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.

- 1.2.2 Where provided by the Organising Authority and where practicable, a boat shall display a Logicalis self-adhesive sticker(s) on her bow(s) throughout the Regatta.

### 1.3 RESPONSIBILITY

- 1.3.1 Yacht racing can be dangerous. The attention of Persons in Charge is drawn to RRS Fundamental Rule 4: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone" and to Special Regulation 1.02.1 which begins: "The safety of a yacht and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the Person in Charge..." Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
  - a) they are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
  - b) they are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
  - c) they accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the

extent caused by their own actions or omission;  
 d) their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;  
 e) the provision of a race management team and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;  
 f) they are responsible for ensuring that their boat is equipped and seaworthy so as to face extremes of weather; that there is a crew sufficient in number, experience and fitness to withstand such weather; and that the safety equipment is properly maintained, stowed, in date and familiar to the crew.

1.3.2 The GRA, its sponsors, and other organising clubs accept no responsibility or liability for loss of life or injury to members or others, or for the loss of, or damage to, any vessel or property.

1.3.3 The Race Committee will make starting signals unless in their opinion it is manifestly unsafe for any of the boats entered to remain in the vicinity of the starting line. Each boat shall exercise her responsibility under RRS Fundamental Rule 4 and decide whether or not to start or to continue to race.

1.3.4 No boat will be accepted as an entry unless the Person in Charge has, before the start of the race, signed a declaration in the terms set out in NoR 1.10.

## 1.4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

1.4.1 The Regatta is open to boats of the following classes:

- 1.4.1.1 **Cruiser Class 1** (including Sportsboat) – National Handicap
- 1.4.1.2 **Cruiser Class 2** - National Handicap
- 1.4.1.3 **Cruiser Class 3** – National Handicap
- 1.4.1.4 **Class 4** - Dayboat (including small traditional open boat) – Dayboat Handicap
- 1.4.1.5 **Class 5** – Windsurfer

1.4.1.6 **Class 6** - Open dinghy - Portsmouth Yardstick Number greater than 1195

1.4.1.7 **Class 7** - Open dinghy - Portsmouth Yardstick Number equal to or less than 1195

1.4.1.8 **Class 8** – Optimist Regatta Fleet

1.4.1.9 Notes:

- Classes 1, 2 and 3 will comprise cruiser/racer boats and the Organising Authority will determine the bands forming Classes 1-3 on the basis of the range of boats by the entry cut-off date;
- Classes 1-3. Any boats in these classes with a valid IRC Rating should include their rating on their entry form.
- Class flags – each boat in Classes 1, 2, 3 and 4 shall provide its own class flag to be flown from the back-stay or, if no backstay exists, push-pit whilst racing. Class flags are numeral pennants 1, 2, 3 and 4 respectively;
- Classes 6 and 7 will comprise dinghies with a 2016 Portsmouth Yardstick (PY) number as published by St Catherine's Sailing Club.
- Windsurfers must race using Mistral boards and sail sizes per class rules.

1.4.2 GRA races are open to boats in possession of a valid a NHC Base Number (BN). A BN will be allocated by GRA to all Cruiser Classes.

1.4.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and delivering it to GRA by the Closing Date.

1.4.4 Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

1.4.5 The following restrictions on the number of boats apply:

- There shall be a minimum of 2 entries in each Class to constitute a valid series for that Class.

- A sole race competitor may start a race and optionally sail the course to qualify for appropriate series points.

1.4.6 Competitors will be informed on the Gorey Regatta Association website after the Closing Date in which Class they will be racing.

1.4.7 Classes and Class Flags are outlined under Part 2 Appendix 1.

## 1.5 COURSES

1.5.1 Courses will be outlined in Part 2 and detailed in the Sailing Instructions. The Race Committee may set different courses for different *Classes*.

## 1.6 FEES

1.6.1 Fees will apply to entries received by 1800 hours Thursday 9th June, as follows:

Classes 1, 2, 3 - £24.00

Classes 4, 5, 6, 7 - £19.00 or £16.00 where a boat is to be entirely crewed by persons aged 16 years and under throughout the event; Class 8 - £5.00

1.6.2 Fees include race entry, attendance at the Friday evening reception and one free ticket per boat for Sunday's prize-giving and buffet. Class 8 entry does not include free ticket for the prize giving. Extra prize-giving buffet tickets are subject to availability at £12.00 each.

1.6.3 Fees will not be refunded except at the Organising Authority's sole discretion;

1.6.4 **Members of Gorey Regatta Association** (as at 9<sup>th</sup> June) are entitled to one £5.00 discount on the above entry fees per membership subscription.

1.6.5 **Saturday Social tickets** (optional) - Saturday 11<sup>th</sup> June - Adults £12.00 each; junior competitors (those aged 12 years and under on 11<sup>th</sup> June 2016) £6.00 each;

## 1.7 PENALTIES

1.7.1 Taking a penalty (RRS44), unless changed by the Sailing Instructions, the penalty for breaking a rule of RRS Part 2 shall be a Two Turns Penalty as permitted and described in RRS 44.2.

1.7.2 Penalties for infringements of other rules will be detailed in the Sailing Instructions.

## 1.8 COMMUNICATION

1.8.1 A boat may, without infringing RRS 41, request and receive repetition of information broadcast by the Race Committee, or be told whether or not a broadcast has been made.

1.8.2 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## 1.9 SCORING

1.9.1 The Low Point System of scoring as described in Appendix A will be used.

1.9.2 No discards are allowed except for the Orviss Cup for Dayboats where two discards are allowed races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

1.9.3 The final sentence in RRS A3 – Scoring is modified to read "However, when a handicap or rating system is used a boat's corrected time, rounded to the nearest second, shall determine her finishing place".

## 1.10 BERTHING

1.10.1 Classes 1 to 4 are to make their own arrangements if wishing to moor at Gorey. Please note Gorey Harbour dries out at low tide. Boats wishing to stay overnight must be able to take the ground. There are some nearby deep-water moorings that are very exposed and are used at the owner's entire risk.

1.10.2 Classes 5 to 8 may use the beach and ensure boats are kept above the high water mark if left unattended overnight.

## 1.11 RACE PRIZES AND TROPHIES

1.11.1 The trophies to be awarded for a race are outlined in Part 2.

### **1.12 RACE ENTRY DECLARATION**

- 1.12.1 The Person in Charge for each race shall agree to the terms of the declaration on the entry form below submit a completed signed copy to GRA before the Closing Date.

### **1.13 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

- 1.13.1 Competitors participate in the series entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organising

Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the series.

### **1.14 INSURANCE**

- 1.14.1 Boats shall be adequately and suitably insured before racing and have in force a valid third party liability insurance cover, including racing, to a minimum of £3,000,000.

2.4.1 Courses will be set in Grouville Bay, extending northwards toward St Catherine and will comprise one or more laid marks and/or one or more fixed marks, or a combination of both as illustrated on the

Gorey Regatta Course Card that will be provided with the Sailing Instructions.

2.4.2 The course card is available to download from <http://www.goreyregatta.org/>.

### 2.5 SCORING

2.5.1 No discards are allowed except for the Orviss Cup for Dayboats where two discards are allowed races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

### 2.6 PRIZES

- 2.6.1 Perpetual trophies will be awarded as indicated in the Race Programme (Appendix 1) and are not to be taken out of Jersey;
- 2.6.2 Place prizes will be awarded in each class, as follows:
- 2.6.3 When 2 boats are entered - a first prize only will be awarded;
- 2.6.4 When 3 boats are entered - first and second prizes only will be awarded;
- 2.6.5 A team race, Gorey v Carteret/Port Bail for the Frank Jeune Trophy will be awarded on a points basis from both the Fairey Cup and the C. Austin Potter Trophy for Class 3.
- 2.6.6 Additional special prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee & the Event Sponsors.

### 2.7 PRIZEGIVING

2.7.1 Place prizes will be awarded at The Mooring Hotel following the end of racing on Sunday 12<sup>th</sup> June 2016. As soon as possible after 18:30 hours.
