## Notice of Race

### 1. RULES

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*;
- 1.2. *The Racing Rules* will be changed, as follows:
  - 1.2.1. For Class 4, Rule 44.1 is changed in that only one turn is required;
- 1.3. The Sailing Instructions may change other racing rules;
- 1.4. The Prescriptions of the Royal Yachting Association will apply;
- 1.5. IRC Rules 2018, parts A, B and C will apply except that Rule 22.4 will not apply. There will be no limitations on crew weight or numbers A personal flotation device (PFD) shall be carried for every person on board;
- 1.6. The Exoneration Penalty, Advisory Hearing and RYA Arbitration of the RYA Rules Disputes Procedures will be available. Decisions from RYA Arbitration can be referred to a protest committee but cannot be reopened or appealed.

2. **ADVERTISING** – When provided and where practicable, a boat shall endeavour to display a Logicalis sticker on her bow(s) whilst she is racing.

### 3. ELIGIBILITY

#### 3.1. Cruiser/racer classes

- 3.1.1. Class 1 (including Sportsboat) - Boats with a Spinlock IRC Rating equal to or greater than 0.950
- 3.1.2. Class 2 - Boats with a Spinlock IRC Rating less than 0.950;
- 3.1.3. Class 3 - Boats without an IRC rating, scored under a Gorey Regatta rating;
- 3.1.4. Class 4 - Dayboat - Jersey Dayboat rating (available on application);
- 3.1.5. Class 5 - Windsurfer;



### 3.2. Dinghy (RYA Portsmouth Yardstick Number)

- 3.2.1. Class 6 - PY number greater than 1207
- 3.2.2. Class 7 - PY number equal to or less than 1207
- 3.2.3. Class 8 - Optimist Training Fleet.

#### Notes:

- 1 A minimum of **two** entries is required for a class to race;
- 2 Classes 1 and 2 – the Organising Authority will determine the bands forming these Classes on the basis of the range of boats entered by the cut-off date;
- 3 Class flags – boats in Classes 1, 2 & 3 shall provide their own class flags, to be flown from the back-stay or, where no backstay exists, the push-pit whilst racing. Class flags are numeral pennants 1, 2 & 3 respectively;
- 4 Class 5 - Kona boards, only, will be used; sail sizes will be as per class rules;
- 5 Classes 6 and 7 will comprise dinghies with 2018 PY Numbers as published by St Catherine's SC;
- 6 Class 7 - entries will be accepted from competitors aged 10 years and above. Entries may be accepted from younger entrants with recognised race experience at the Organising Committee's sole discretion.

## 4. ENTRY

- 4.1. Eligible boats shall enter by completing the attached entry form and delivering it with the relevant entry fee to the GRA **no later than** Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> June;
- 4.2. Late entries will be accepted up to Friday 29<sup>th</sup> June on payment of the late entry fee, shown below;
- 4.3. The final classification of entries will be posted on [www.goreyregatta.org](http://www.goreyregatta.org) no later than Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> July.

## 5. FEES

- 5.1. For Classes 0, 1, 2 and 3 the entry fee for entry is £25 per boat;
- 5.2. For Classes 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 the entry fee is also £25 per boat except that the entry fee for those entrants aged 16 years and under throughout the Regatta will be £18 per boat;
- 5.3. **The late entry fee, for all classes, will be £30;**
- 5.4. Fees include race entry, a complimentary drink at the Dolphin Hotel on Friday evening, BBQ on the beach on Saturday evening (bring your own food and drink) and **one** complimentary ticket per boat for the Sunday prize-giving and buffet. Additional tickets at £13.00 each are subject to availability;
- 5.5. Fees will not be refunded other than at the Organising Authority's sole discretion.



## 6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. Schedule 1 shows the provisional race programme; to be confirmed in the Sailing Instructions;
- 6.2. Races not run on either day for whatever reason will be abandoned;
- 6.3. Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> July – no warning signal will be made after 1630 hours; races not started by that time will be abandoned.

## 7. MEASUREMENT

- 7.1. Each boat with a 2018 Spinlock IRC Rating shall enter her Rating on her entry form;
- 7.2. Each boat in Class 3 will be allocated a Gorey Regatta rating;
- 7.3. Except for the provision in Para 1.3, above, boats shall comply with Rule 78.1 (compliance with Class Rules, Certificates).

8. **SAILING INSTRUCTIONS** will be available on [www.goreyregatta.org](http://www.goreyregatta.org) no later than Monday 25<sup>th</sup> June.

9. **THE COURSES** will be set in Grouville Bay, extending northwards towards St Catherine and will comprise one or more laid marks and/or one or more fixed marks or a combination of both as illustrated in the Gorey Regatta course card available on [www.goreyregatta.org](http://www.goreyregatta.org) and to be included in the Sailing Instructions.

10. **PENALTY SYSTEM** - For Class 4, Rule 44.1 is changed in that only one turn is required.

## 11. SCORING

- 11.1. The Low Point System of Appendix A will apply;
- 11.2. No discards will be allowed except for the Orviss Cup for Dayboats where one discard will be allowed when three races have been completed. Two races are required to be completed to constitute the series.

12. **GUARD BOATS** will fly a green flag.

## 13. BERTHING

- 13.1. Classes 1 to 4 must make their own arrangements for mooring at Gorey. Gorey Harbour dries; boats wishing to stay overnight must be able to take the ground. Nearby deepwater moorings are available but are very exposed. Their use is entirely at the person-in-charge's risk;
- 13.2. Classes 5 to 8 may use the beach. Persons in charge must ensure that boats are kept above the high water mark if they are to be left unattended overnight.



#### **14. RADIO COMMUNICATION**

- 14.1. The Race Committee will communicate with boats in Classes 1 to 4 on VHF Channel 8;
- 14.2. A boat may request and receive a repetition/confirmation of information broadcast by the Race Committee on VHF Channel 8;
- 14.3. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.

#### **15. PRIZES & PRIZE-GIVING**

- 15.1. Place prizes and trophies will be awarded in the Moorings Hotel as soon as possible after 1830 hrs, Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> July;
- 15.2. Trophies are shown in Schedule 1;
- 15.3. Trophies shall not be removed from Jersey;
- 15.4. Place prizes will be awarded in each Class, as follows:
  - 15.4.1. Where two boats are entered – first prize only;
  - 15.4.2. Where three boats are entered – first and second prizes only;
  - 15.4.3. Where four boats are entered – first, second and third prizes only;
- 15.5. Special prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Race Committee and the event sponsors.

#### **16. RISK STATEMENT** – Rule 4 of the *Racing Rules of Sailing* states: ‘The responsibility for a boat’s decision to participate in a race or to continue is hers alone’.

Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

- 16.1. They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
- 16.2. They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
- 16.3. They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
- 16.4. Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;
- 16.5. The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organiser does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- 16.6. The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;



16.7. It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event.

**17. INSPECTIONS** – The fact that race officials may conduct inspections of a boat does not reduce the responsibilities of each competitor set out in this Notice of Race.

**18. INSURANCE** - Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of £3,000,000 (three million) or the equivalent in euros, per incident, to include racing throughout the event.
